

Season

- Winter
 - Santa Ana provides a warm winter and potential for local wave, 40mile ridge and/or a washing machine
 - Winter storms bring wave and good unstable days after
- Spring
 - More thermal days starting in April, typically a few 1000km days
- Summer
 - Typically avoid June
 - Convergence sometimes with clouds
- Fall
 - Through mid October is still strong thermal
 - Santa Ana starts

Ridge


- East wind ridge day

Wave


- Gentleman wave

- Tow to Econo Wave
- Thermal into root
- Ridge Soar and drop in


Thermal

- Standard milk-run on the sheer line




Good southern Launch

- Early starts on good days, launching before 9am








